

At least how many cores are needed in an indoor optical cable





Overview

A simple rule is that each device needs two cores—one for sending and one for receiving data. The total number of cores for a 1pc fiber patch cable is calculated as the number of branches multiplied by the number of cores per branch (if there are no branches, the number of branches = 1). Of course, this is a general situation, and specific words may consider according to the following criteria.
