

Connect the third-level distribution box to the ground





Overview

Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The common configuration typically involves three key points: the live, neutral, and ground. Depending on your installation, you'll likely use either a 10 AWG or 8 AWG size, but. It contains multiple circuit breakers and connects various electrical circuits to ensure the safe flow of electricity throughout the building. A subpanel serves as a secondary electrical distribution point that receives power from the main service panel, extending the home's electrical capacity.
