Overview

The mandatory colors for power wiring in the National Electrical Code (NEC) are Green, Bare, or Green/Yellow (a yellow stripe or band on green) for the protective ground (PG), and White (or alternatively Gray) for the neutral wire. Many countries, including the UK (BS-7671), China, Russia, Hong Kong, Singapore, Ukraine, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Turkey, Israel, South Africa, Argentina, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia (KSA), and the UAE, have adopted the IEC wiring color codes. Most European countries follow a wire color code established by the International Electro-technical Commission (IEC).
