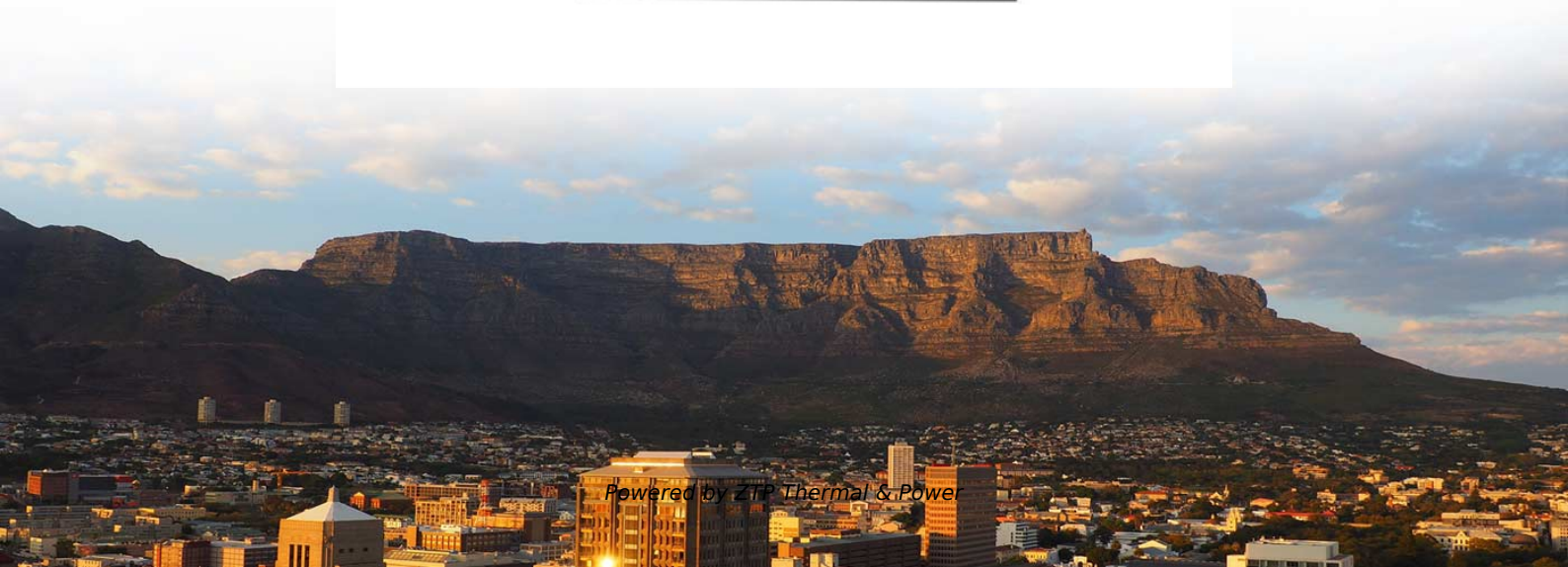


Do you need qualifications to dismantle a telecommunications tower





Overview

Quick Answer: To become a tower technician, complete a training program at a trade school or technical institute (2-6 months for a certificate), then earn required safety certifications (OSHA 10, TTT, Competent Climber/Rescuer). PTTG has experienced crews available to help when owners determine they no longer need their tanks, towers, or other structures and require them to be dismantled and removed, including scrap disposal and site cleanup.
