

Fiberglass floater tail cracking





Overview

This guide covers a practical workflow for fiberglass boat crack repair, focusing on safe techniques using marine epoxy resin, fiberglass cloth, and careful fairing. These cracks are almost always confined to the thick, brittle outer gelcoat layer and don't actually reach the fiberglass laminate underneath. They pop up in high-stress areas, like near cleats or around stanchions, where the hull flexes. Fiberglass is one of the most durable materials used in boat construction but is not indestructible. The good news?

With a fiberglass repair kit and some basic tools, you can often fix these issues yourself. One of the worst feelings on the water is discovering a crack in your hull, a blister on its bottom, or a gouge in the topsides.
