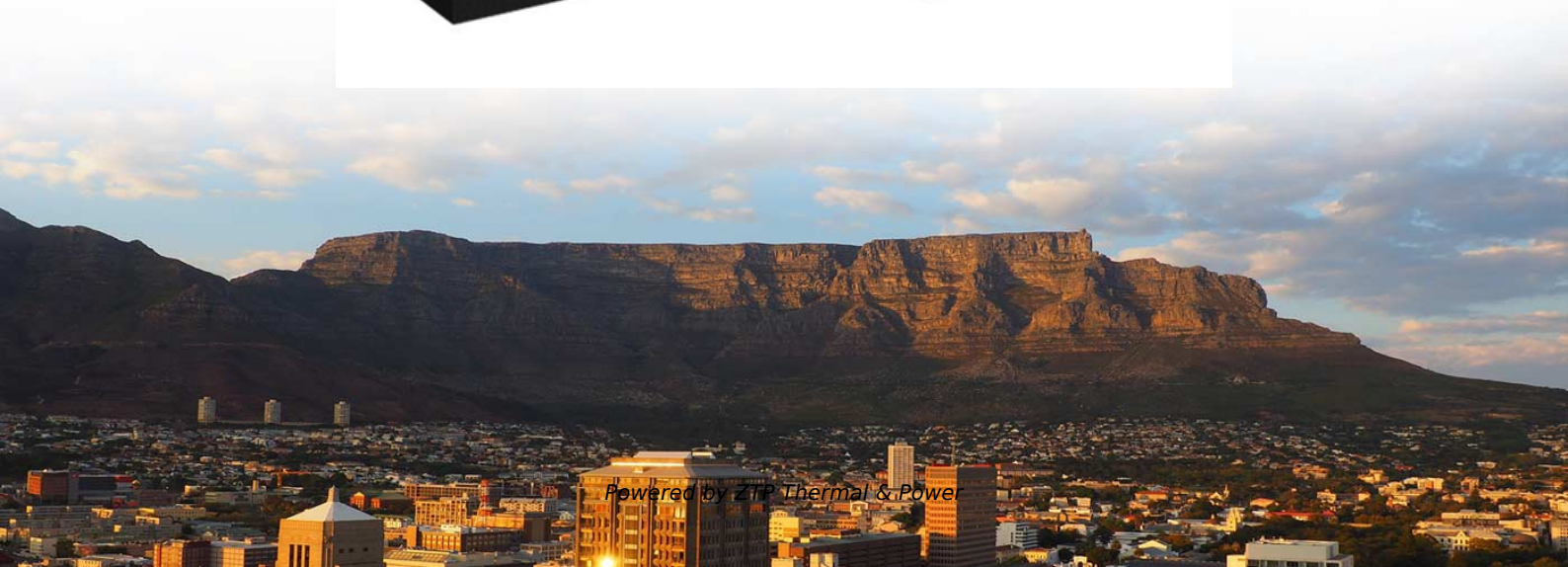


Garbled characters when accessing the switch s console port





Overview

Ensure your console cable is properly recognized by checking the 'Ports (COM & LPT)' section. Additionally, on the actual device, running diagnostic commands from the terminal can help identify where the break in. On routers, the config register also holds the information about the console port speed. If I start a PuTTY session (same Problem in other software) then there are a lot of characters wrong. These can result from various factors such as incorrect settings, faulty cables, or incompatible terminal software.

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Nothing or Garbled Characters Are Displayed on the Console Port

After a device is started, nothing or garbled characters are displayed on the Console port. 1. Check the power module indicators. If the indicators are in normal state, the power module is not faulty. If the

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Console shows unrecognizable characters due to a faulty port
