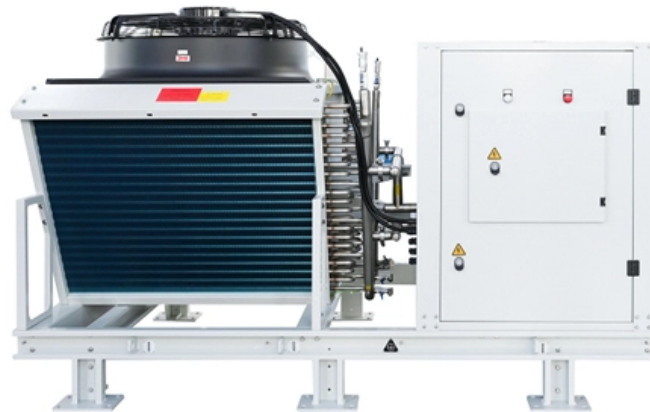


How did I remove the fiber optic protective sleeve





Overview

Here are the steps to remove the cap: Step 1: Hold the optical cable firmly but gently to avoid any bending. However, if the cap is too tight to pull using your finger, you can use a pair of soft-tipped tweezers to remove it gently. Basically I want to remove the green end of the fiber cable so that I could pull it back through the hole in the baseboard and run it elsewhere. This procedure includes instructions for any rare "worst case" connectors which are reissued, **WARNING: Laser light can damage your eye.**

Remove the excess fiber with a straight, non-twisting pull and deposit in a safe place (i.e. onto a piece of tape or in the debris container). Note1: If fiber does not readily pull off, repeat previous step - scoring
