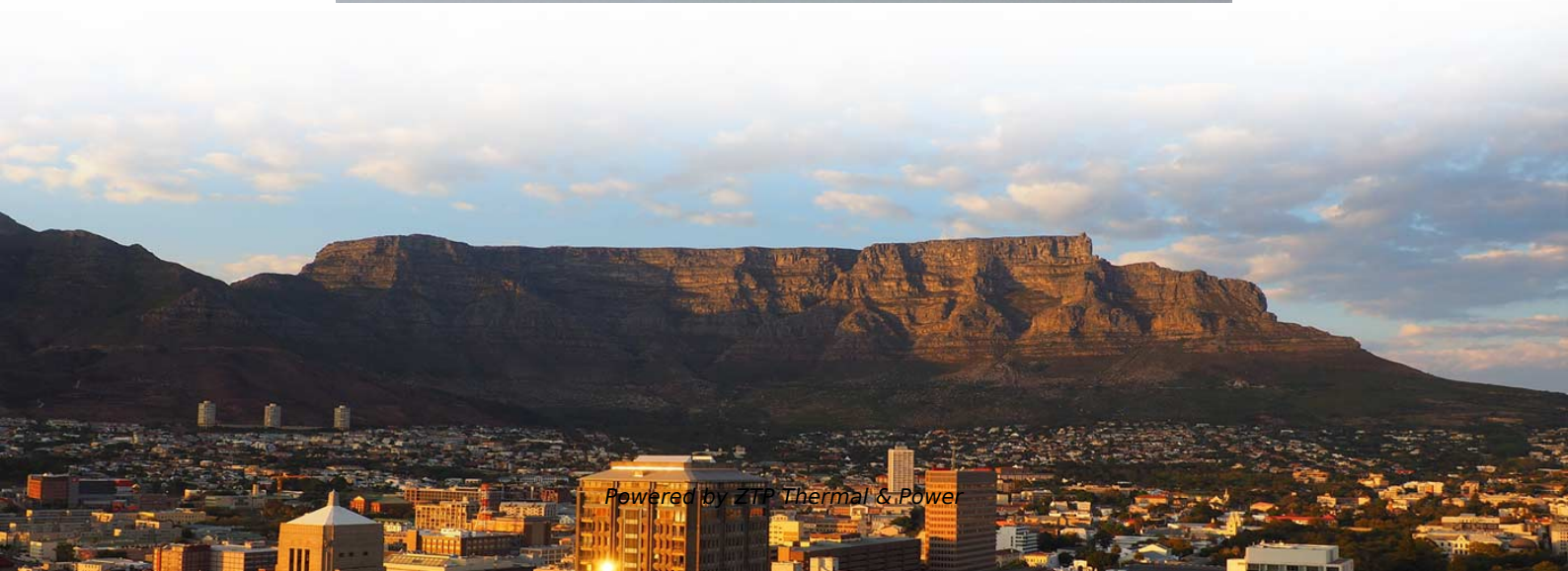


How to plug a pigtail into a device





Overview

This method involves connecting the circuit's main wires to a short jumper wire, or pigtail, which then connects to the terminal of the device. The pigtail plug connector may seem like a small and insignificant piece of technology, but its impact is far from minor. An electrical pigtail connector is a short length of wire — pre-terminated on one or both ends — used to extend, repair, or adapt a wiring connection.
