How to seal up cables in vertical shaft cable trays





Overview

The use of nonmechanical systems of material--putties, caulk and foam--that are capable of fitting around or in irregular cables and pipes to seal off openings is more common. Scope: Firestopping for busway, cable trays, cables, and trunking passing through walls in enclosed electrical installations. Typical applications of vertical cable installations are connections to hydro power generation plants in a cavern, underground mining applications, open pit mines, high-rise buildings, or submarine crossings. Various publications are available in the field such as "500kV Aluminum-Sheathed XLPE. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray.
