The electrical panel, often called a breaker box, is the central distribution point for your home's electrical system. It manages the incoming power supply, distributing it safely through various circuits and using circuit breakers to prevent overcurrent situations that could cause a fire. On top, look for a location that is free of moisture, humidity, and obstructions. There are two types of tests a registered electrician can carry out in your kitchen: an Electrical Installation Condition Report (EICR) and in-service inspection and testing. Kitchen islands are required to have at least one GFCI outlet or a regular outlet connected to a GFCI outlet installed for code compliance.
