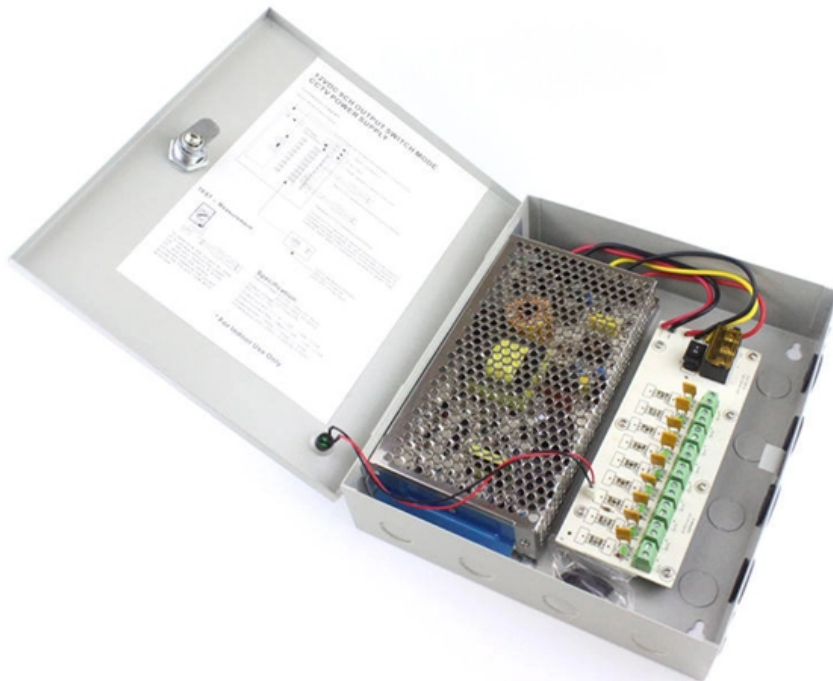


Mali Single-Fiber Bidirectional QSFP-DD





Overview

QSFP-DD is a new module and cage/connector system similar to current QSFP, but with an additional row of contacts providing for an eight lane electrical interface. It is being developed by the QSFP-DD MSA as a key part of the industry's effort to enable high-speed solutions. Simple to deploy, this compact adaptor doubles fiber capacity while avoiding costly new fiber/transceiver deployments and frees up fiber for other. The QSFP-DD (Quad Small Form-factor Pluggable - Double Density) form-factor is used for 200G, 400G and 800G applications and is backward compatible with lower speed QSFP+, QSFP28, QSFP56 and QSFP112 technologies.
