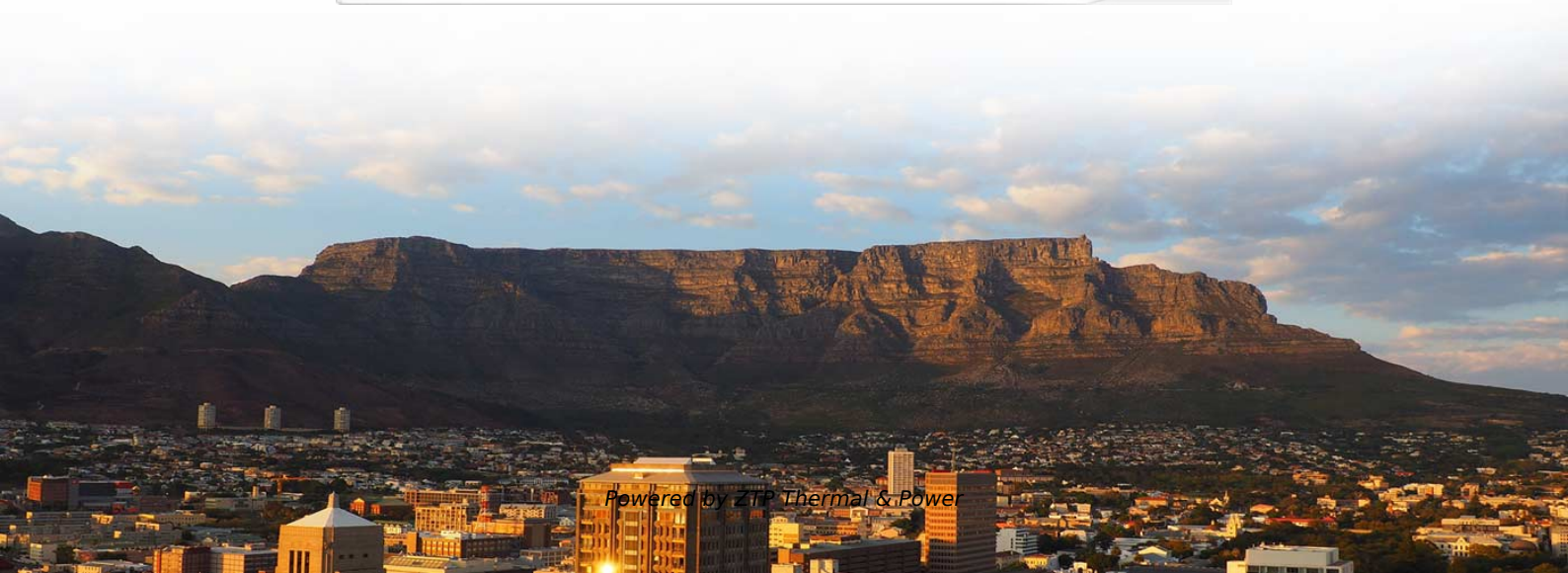


North Korea establishes fiber optic communication network





Overview

Online services for most individuals and institutions are provided through a free known as, with access to the global Internet.
