The 25 de Abril Bridge (Portuguese: Ponte 25 de Abril, 25th of April Bridge, Portuguese pronunciation: [ˈpõti ˈvĩti (i) ˈsĩku di eˈbril]) is a suspension bridge connecting the city of Lisbon, capital of Portugal, with the municipality of Almada on the left (south) bank of the. 4 miles (2,277 meters) long, the 25 de Abril Bridge holds the record for the longest suspension bridge in Europe and was the first bridge to be built in Lisbon. The bridge spans the Tejo Estuary at its narrowest point and is the only bridge leading south out of the city This impressive bridge closely resembles the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco, with its name.
