Overview

Numerous Guyana Telephone and Telegraph Company (GTT) residential and commercial fibre optic internet subscribers are without service after a fire at a huge heap of garbage on Robb and Alexander streets destroyed several telecoms cables. Guyana suffered a major international telephone and Internet outage for around five hours on Wednesday due to damage to the offshore Suriname-Guyana Submarine Cable System (SGSCS). ENet has suffered damage to its fiber cable under the Essequibo River caused by a marine vessel, resulting in disrupted internet and TV services along the Essequibo Coast.
