

Standard installation distance for level 3 distribution boxes





Overview

The distance between the distribution box and the switch box should not exceed 30 meters, and the horizontal distance between the switch box and the fixed electrical equipment it controls should not exceed 3 meters. Let's break it down into two main parts: the outer shell and the electrical parts inside.
