Overview

Tonga Cable System is a system connecting with, where it connects to other international networks. It has cable landing points at Sopo, a suburb of Nuku'alofa in Tonga, and Suva, Fiji. Not a metro area, not a data center cluster — a sovereign nation of roughly 105,000 people, spread across an archipelago of more than 150 islands in the South Pacific, whose international connectivity depends on a. The cable cost was around T\$36 million and was financed through grants from the World Bank Group and the Asian Development Bank.
