- Resetting the Relay (OFF State): A brief pulse to the "reset" coil moves the contacts back to the OFF position. Since the contacts hold their position magnetically or mechanically, no continuous power is needed to maintain the state. Auto / manual reset can use a momentary normally open pushbutton, manual reset, or a jumper, auto reset, for resetting the relay.
