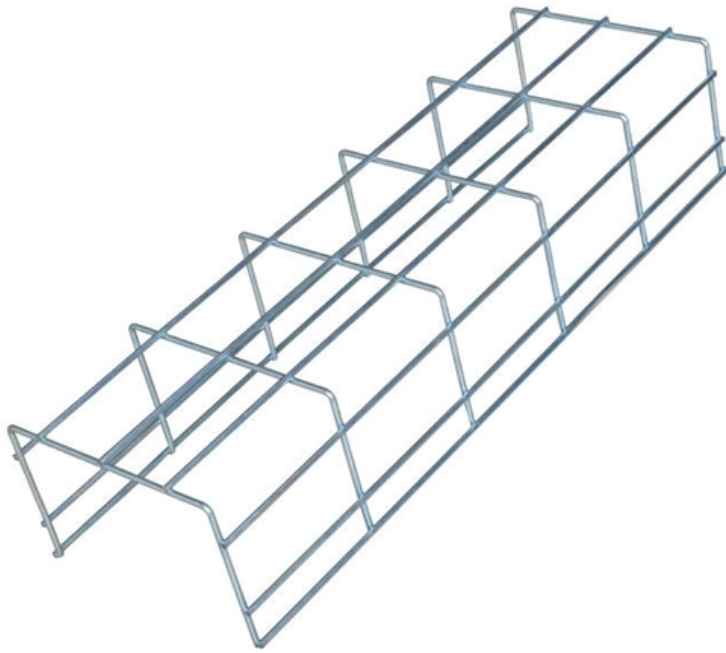


What wires should be connected to the secondary distribution box

According to NEC Article 250, both the neutral and ground wires must be connected only in the main panel or at the first service disconnect. They should never be connected together downstream of the service equipment, such as in subpanels or other parts of the circuits. There is a neutral/grounding bar on each side of the box, are these connected to each other?

It has white insulated wires and bare ground wires attached to each.
