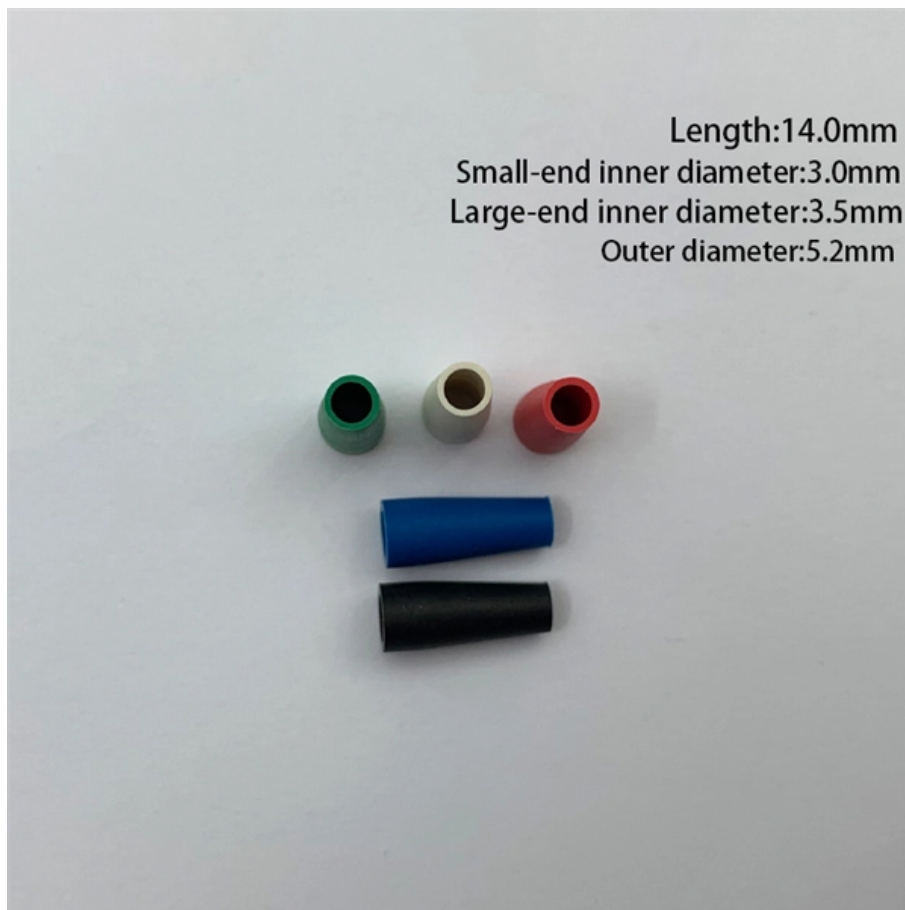


Zimbabwe Mobile Fiber Communication





Overview

The agreement, signed Tuesday, June 17, aims to develop a resilient, high-capacity national backbone network to strengthen the country's digital transformation. Zimbabwe is advancing its fiber optic infrastructure through a new partnership between PowerTel Communications—a subsidiary of the national electricity company—and Paratus Zimbabwe. Its ability to provide high-speed internet without cables or towers made it very attractive, especially in rural areas where internet access has always been poor.
